BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MINUTES OF MARCH 29, 2018

Recommendation by Mr. Margraf to defer approval of the minutes of the meeting of March 22, 2018; Ms. Garay concurred.

Agreement received from First Group Engineering, Inc. for construction inspection in the Hohman Avenue – Huehn Street to 200 feet north of 141st Street project with a cost of \$137,647.61.
