## <u>MINUTES</u> BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY <u>APRIL 30, 2017</u>

Corporation Counsel, Ms. Kristina Kantar, said the Indiana General Assembly has passed a piece of legislation which requires local municipalities to have any control of cell towers or repeaters to enact an ordinance or resolution prior to May 1, 2017, which is tomorrow. Ms. Kantar then said the Resolution before the Board today will require any cell towers or repeaters be placed underground. Ms. Kantar then requested the Board pass the Resolution as presented.
