PRELIMINARY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TARGET AREA RESOLUTION FOR TAX ABATEMENT

2842 Carlson Drive, Hammond, Indiana OXBOW LANDING LOT 1

TEN (10) YEAR TAX ABATEMENT REQUEST FOR REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 6-1.1-12.1-1 et seq. (the "Act") allows a partial

abatement of property taxes attributable to redevelopment or rehabilitation activities in

"Economic Development Target Areas" as those terms are defined in the Act, and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that such Economic Development Target Areas are

areas within the City which have:

"...become undesirable or impossible for normal development and occupancy because of lack of development, cessation of growth, deterioration of improvements or character of occupancy, age, obsolescence, substandard buildings or other factors which have impaired values or prevent a normal development of property or use of property;"

IC 6-1.1-12.1-7; and

WHEREAS, 2.78 acres of real estate located at 2842 Carlson Drive, in the City of

Hammond, Lake County, Indiana, which is legally described as follows: Lot 1 Block 1 in

Oxbow Landing Addition to the City of Hammond as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat

Book 105, page 1, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana; Parcel No. 45-

07-16-405-003.000-023, is hereinafter referred to as the "Real Estate"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond Department of Planning and Development is desirous of having the Real Estate designated as an Economic Development Target Area for the purpose of achieving property tax savings in connection with the following activities (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") on the Real Estate:

Construction of a hotel which may include retail food and beverage or other retail.

WHEREAS, the Common Council shall consider the following objectives in

making a decision about Economic Development Target Areas designation:

Effective utilization of vacant urban land; stabilization and conservation of neighborhood; rehabilitation and replacement of obsolete and deteriorated structures; improvement in the physical appearance of the City of Hammond; efficient utilization of energy; avoidance of environmental harm; creation of new jobs; and retention of existing jobs; and

WHEREAS, it appears the Project will maintain and/or increase the property tax

base through new construction as that term is defined in the Act, the creation of up to ten

(10) temporary jobs per new construction in the City of Hammond, and that the Project

will meet the City's development objectives, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Hammond as follows:

1. The Common Council will conduct a public hearing on June 9, 2014, in the Council Chambers, Hammond City Hall, 5925 Calumet Avenue, Hammond, Indiana for receiving of remonstrances and objections from persons interested in or affected by the Project.

2. The Real Estate may be designated within the Economic Development Target area as that term is defined in the Act. This designation is for real property tax abatement and the designation period shall not be limited.

3. The Real Estate may be approved for <u>TEN (10)</u> years of tax abatement for real estate and the property owner shall submit a Statement of Benefits form.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council that the resolution shall have full force and effect from and after the public hearing hereon, passage and approval hereof by the Common Council, signing by the President thereof, and approval and signing by the Mayor.
