ORDINANCE NO. 9258

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORD. NO. 9249 RELATING TO WEEDS, DEBRIS
AND OTHER MATTER AT PROPERTIES SUBJECT TO DEMOLITION

WHEREAS, Ordinance 9249 was recently passed by the Common Council to provide for the cutting of offensive weeds, etc. on neglected or abandoned property in the City of Hammond; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that such conditions are often found on property subject to an order of demolition, and such properties are very likely to cause serious blight affecting the neighborhood in which they are located.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDANINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMMOND as follows:

Ordinance 9249 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

“The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to and be strictly enforced as to any property subject to an order of demolition. In addition to grass, weeds, vegetation, and undergrowth, debris and other unsightly matter shall be removed from such property as soon as practical.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective from and after passage by the Common Council, signing by the President of the Council, approval and signing by the Mayor or by override of any veto by the Council.
