ORDINANCE NO. 9557

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HOHMAN AVENUE AND 142ND STREET

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Common Council of the City of Hammond to provide for the public safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hammond; and


WHEREAS, crossing guards, parents and children currently feel at risk because many children and parents cross there and cars speed and disregard the crossing guard. The 4-way stop should reduce speeds of cars on Hohman Avenue thereby reducing risk of injury and increasing confidence that all people can safely cross Hohman Avenue to get to Lincoln and St. Casimir schools as well as to the commercial business at that intersection; and

WHEREAS, in carrying out this responsibility, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of said citizens that 4-way stop signs should be established at the intersection of Hohman Avenue and 142nd Street in the City of Hammond.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

The Common Council of the City of Hammond designates that 4-way stop signs shall be posted at the intersection of Hohman Avenue and 142nd Street requiring vehicular traffic from all four directions to come to a complete stop before entering the intersection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Common Council that this Ordinance shall have full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Common Council, signing by the President of the Common Council, and publication according to law.


