

MINUTES
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
MARCH 19, 2015

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Public Works & Safety convened at 9:00 a.m., in Council Chambers of Hammond City Hall. A roll call was taken: Mr. Krusa - present; Mr. Dostatni - present; Mr. Smith - present.

Motion by Mr. Dostatni to approve the minutes of the meeting March 5, 2015; seconded by Mr. Smith. AYES ALL. Motion carried.

Request for advertising dates of March 26, 2015 and April 2, 2015 with a bid opening date of April 16, 2015 for the 2nd District Local Street Lighting Improvement Project - 4300 and 4400 blocks of Hickory Avenue, 4300 block of Ash Avenue and 149th Street from Columbia Avenue to White Oak Avenue and for the demolition of 4611 Ash Avenue. Motion by Mr. Dostatni to approve dates for both projects; seconded by Mr. Smith. AYES ALL. Motion carried. (Res. No. 2846 and ****)
