RESOLUTION NO. B27

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LAKE COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to its residents and property; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is to identify hazards and the extent they affect a municipality, and formulate mitigation practices to ultimately reduce the social, physical, and economic impact of the hazards; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is a requirement of the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond participated jointly in the planning process with Lake County and other local units of government to develop a multi-jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with the National Flood Insurance Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMMOND hereby adopts the Lake County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Lake County Department of Homeland Security/Emergency Management Agency will submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Indiana Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.






