RESOLUTION NO. R15 **21R-15**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HAMMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT TO
APPLY FOR A 2022 COMPREHENSIVE HIGHWAY INJURY REDUCTION PROGRAM
(CHIRP) GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (ICJI) annually offers Comprehensive Highway Injury Reduction Program (CHIRP) grant money to local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, currently a grant is available for the Hammond Police Department, through the program, which funds are allocated for the purpose of preventing highway injuries and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require matching funds on the part of the municipality and no funds would have to be expended to receive this grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond must complete an application in order to be awarded the requested grant funds and the Hammond Police Department wishes to make this Grant Application and requires the Approval of the Hammond Common Council; and


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Hammond, that the Hammond Police Department be authorized to apply to the ICJI for a 2022 Comprehensive Highway Injury Reduction Program (CHIRP) grant for the purpose of preventing highway injuries and fatalities; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Hammond that this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, signing by the President thereof, and approval by the Mayor.






