RESOLUTION NO. R 03

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HAMMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT TO
APPLY FOR A 2022 SAVE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY GRANT**

WHEREAS, The Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (ICJI) annually offers pedestrian safety grant money to local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, currently a grant is available for the Hammond Police Department through the Stop Arm Violation Enforcement (SAVE) Program, which is allocated for the purpose of providing assistance in the safe transportation of school age pedestrians at school bus pick up and drop off locations; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require matching funds on the part of the municipality and no funds would have to be expended to receive this grant which is being requested in the approximate amount of \$33,000.00; and


WHEREAS, the Hammond Police Department applied to the ICJI for this FY 2022 SAVE grant for the City of Hammond and requires the ratification of said application by the Hammond Common Council; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Hammond, that the Hammond Police Department be authorized to apply to the ICJI for a 2022 SAVE grant for the purpose of assisting in the safe transportation of school age pedestrians at school bus pick up and drop off locations in Hammond; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Hammond that this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, signing by the President thereof and approval by the Mayor.
