INSPECTION OBJECTIVE(s):

To perform an unannounced inspection to evaluate Watco Terminal & Port Services' compliance with applicable air pollution regulations specified in their local operation permit.

SUMMARY OF INSPECTION:

On February 22, 2017 an Annual Inspection was conducted at Watco Terminal & Port Services. This facility holds one (1) operation permit for three (3) Rapid Engineering Direct Gas Fired Heaters.

All three (3) direct gas heaters were in operation.

No violations observed.

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### ENTRY INTERVIEW:

Upon arrival, I met with Joe Maldonado, Terminal Manager for Watco Terminal & Port Services formally Transload Services. I informed him that this is an Annual Inspection, and that I wanted to inspect the three (3) direct gas heaters permitted by this Department.

### INSPECTION OBSERVATION(s):

1. Process Equipment: Rapid Engineering Direct Gas Fired Heaters (3)
2. Process Description:  
Three (3) Rapid Engineering Direct Gas Fired Heaters are used to heat the warehouse and prevent condensation. These units are rated at 16.5 MMBtu/hr heat input combined. These units vent into the building and burn natural gas only.
3. Pollutants Emitted:  
Particulate matter (PM), sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>x</sub>), nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>), volatile organic compounds (VOC), and carbon monoxide (CO)
4. Control Equipment:  
There is no control equipment for these heaters.
5. Applicable Rules:  
326 IAC Article 2 (Permit Review Rules), Hammond Ordinances #7102 (Environmental) and #3522 (as Amended) (Air Pollution Control)
6. Emission Limitations:

All three (3) gas fired heaters were in operation. No modifications or emissions observed.
